





Personal Evangelism

DEFINITION

1. the active sharing of the activity of God in your life,
2. listening to the spiritual needs of the friend you are talking with,
3. regularly praying for your friends,
4. and sharing the gospel content with them, in such a way that God brings conviction of sin and a desire to surrender one's life to Him.



“Sharing of the activity of God in your life”

- Psalm 73:28 (NIV) “But as for me, it is good to be near God. I have made the Sovereign Lord my refuge; I will tell of all your deeds.



“Sharing of the activity of God in your life”

- Isaiah 63:7 (NIV) “I will tell of the kindnesses of the Lord, the deeds for which he is to be praised, according to all the Lord has done for us—yes, the many good things he has done for Israel, according to his compassion and many kindnesses.”



“Sharing of the activity of God in your life”

- 1 Peter 3:15 (NIV) “But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect,

- John 6:44 (ESV) “No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the last day.”**




“listening to the spiritual needs of the friend you are talking with”


