2. What do I hope to get out of this morning?



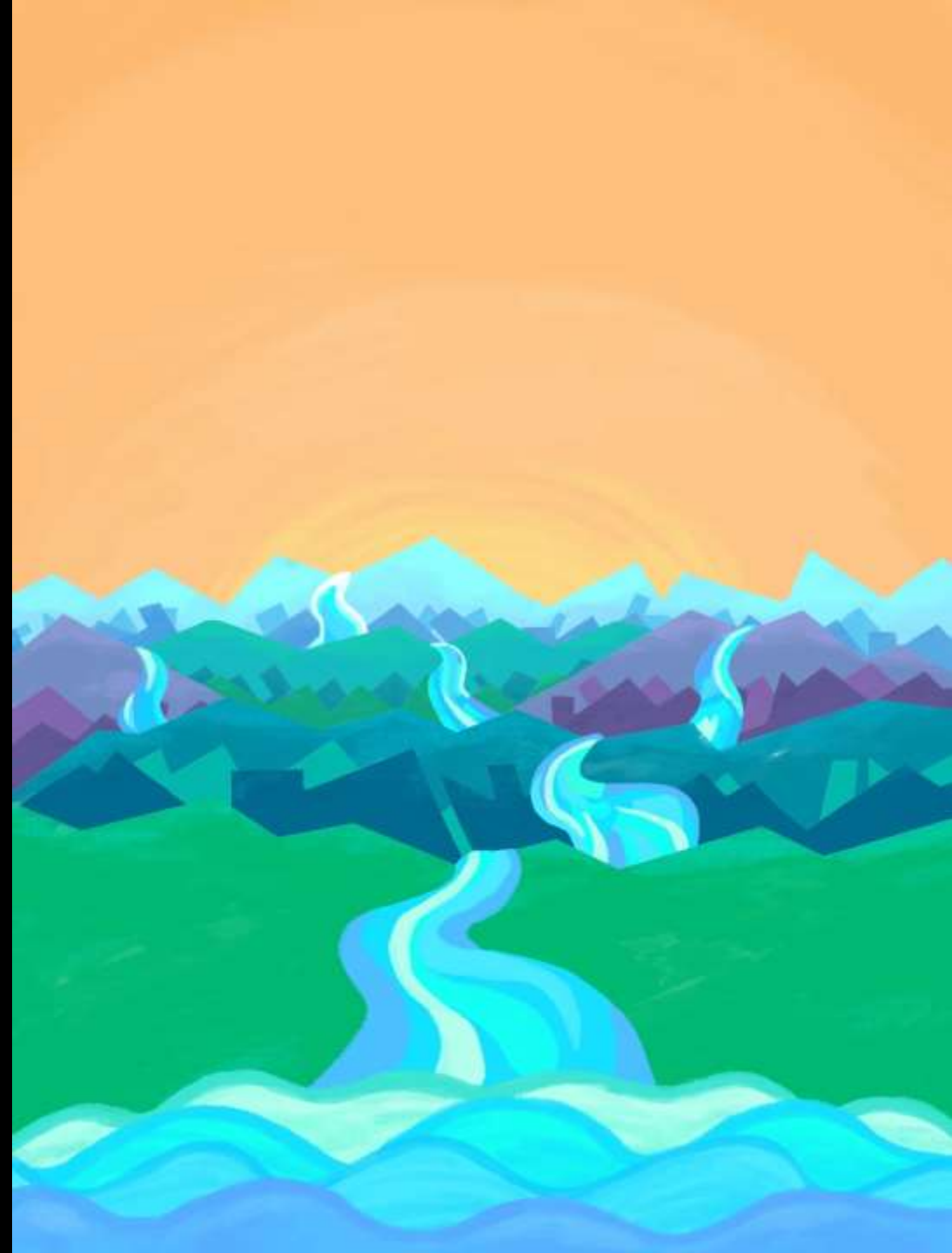
