JESUS COMMANDED US TO
MAKE COMMUNION A REGULAR
PART OF THE CHRISTIAN FAITH

14 And when the hour came, he reclined at table, and the apostles with him. 15 And he said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. 16 For I tell you I will not eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God." 17 And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he said, "Take this, and divide it among yourselves. 18 For I tell you that from now on I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes."

- Luke 22:14-18 ESV

19 And he took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." 20 And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood.

The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?

27 And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he gave it to them, saying, "Drink of it, all of you, 28 for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

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εὐχαριστέω eucharisteō

"Eucharist"

1. **Transubstantiation-** *Bread and wine become the body and blood of Jesus*
2. **Consubstantiation-** *bread remains bread and the wine remains wine, but by faith they are the same as Jesus' actual body.*
3. **John Calvin** taught that *Jesus' presence in the bread and wine is real, but only spiritual, not physical.*
4. **Zwingli** taught that *the bread and wine are significant symbols that represent the body and blood of Jesus.*

- **Metaphor:** *"It's raining cats and dogs"*
- **Simile-** *"I'm sweating like a pig"*
- **Jesus said,** *"I am the vine", "I am the door", "I am the bread of life"*





WHILE THE BREAD AND WINE ARE
NOT JESUS' ACTUAL BODY AND
BLOOD, THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE
SYMBOLS ARE NOT IN ANY WAY
DIMINISHED.


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- Matthew 26:27-28 ESV
